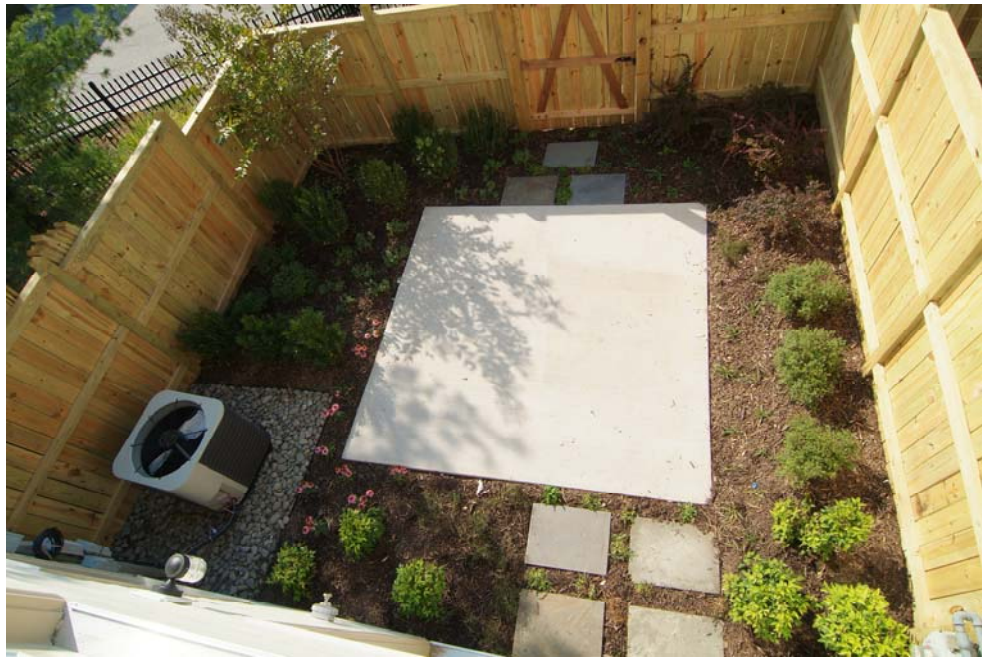

Quaker Hill is a mixed income community comprised of 99 townhomes and 127 condominiums on 4.7 acres in Alexandria, Virginia. Originally developed in 1988, the project replaced part of what was once the 264 unit Cameron Valley public housing development.

The objective of E-Landscape's work at Quaker Hill was to provide a low maintenance outdoor living space in the backyards of the townhomes. Smaller sites are often the most challenging not only from an installation perspective, but from a design standpoint as well. In this case, the space constraints required all onsite work to be completed by hand.

The E-Landscape team designed a solution that did not require any turf maintenance and instead, filled the space with low maintenance shrubs and perennials. Other features included poured concrete patios, decorative gravel, and bluestone stepping stones. As the space matures, the tenants will benefit from a three-season color interest.
